



## GLOW ENERGY PUBLIC COMPANY MONOPOLES - THAILAND

Glow Energy produces power in Thailand. The company provides electricity to the EGAT Public Company and directly supplies electricity, steam, and water to industries. Glow Energy's operations have more than 1,700 MW of electricity capacity, making it the largest private power producer in Thailand.

GEPC decided in 2010 to repair some of their monopoles in 'Eastern Seaboard' (emerging economic region in the Rayong Province, Thailand) and protect them against corrosion using ZINGA.



Each monopole is 56 m high and has a diameter of 2,86 m at its base.

This means each monopole has a total surface area of 350 m<sup>2</sup>.
